DESN 205 – Graphic Design for Electronic Media

PERSONAL WEBSITE DESIGN PROJECT – PART 2

ASSIGNMENT:

Construct a functioning HTML/CSS/JS version of your personal website design from Part 1 of this assignment.

The site must include a home page that provides an overview of who you are and the purpose of the site. The home page must also include an iframe that links to a related web page and a separate embedded social media post. Other pages must include:

- At least one gallery page that will include samples of your design work
- A bio page that outlines your skills, education and accomplishments
- A contact page that includes a form.

You may also incorporate the animation project from DESN 240 if possible

PROCESS:

1. Setup a new site in Dreamweaver by naming it and establishing your site folder. Create the first page save it as *Design*. Create a CSS file and attach it to the first page
2. Insert and style all the structural elements, including the header, navigation, content and footer areas.
3. When this page is complete, save it as a template and create an editable region.
4. Create all the pages for the site from the template and save them. Add the unique content to each page. Be sure to link all pages.
5. Preview the finished site in the browser and check all links and images that they are working.
6. Export the site and send the zipped site folder and STE file to the instructor's gmail account.
